***For Riders of all ages and levels.***

**The Levels**

- Beginner:** Riders 6 years or older; MUST have had a least 3 riding lessons prior to session.
- Beginner/Intermediate:** Riders 6 years of older; should be able to walk and trot.
- Intermediate:** Riders 8 years or older; should be able to walk, trot, canter and jump a course of fences at 2'.
- Advance:** Riders 10 years or older; should be able to walk, trot, canter and jump a course of fences at 2'6".
- Adult:** Riders 18 years or older.

## *The Clinics*

**All Beginner and Beginner Intermediate Sessions will be limited to 6 students per week**

*Please get your applications in early to secure a spot.*

The program will be a five day week program. The morning 9- 12:00 will be the riding lessons and the afternoon 1:00 -3:00 will be horsemanship. Supervised Lunch 12:00-1:00  
You may sign up for full day or half day

**Beginner:** Instruction will include stable management, horse and equipment care, and general horse sense.

**Beginner/Intermediate:** Instruction will include stable management, horse and equipment care and general horse sense. Horse health and maintenance.

**Intermediate:** This program will include stable management, horse and equipment care, horse health, foot care and competition rules and expectations. There will be an introduction to showing, eventing, and foxhunting.

**Advance:** These 3 days will include gymnastics, Horse Show Prep and Cross Country Riding. Also will be in depth care and management of your horse and equipment.
